



Thanksgiving After Communion, May 2021

- 1- Silence of internalization with soft music.
- 2- With the faithful, slowly read the Psalm that follows the First Reading. Conclude with the Prayer after Communion.
- 3- With the faithful, slowly recite a few verses of another Psalm: in May, Psalm 145

*The LORD is gracious and merciful,
slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.
⁹ The LORD is good to all,
and his compassion is over all that he has made.*

*¹⁰ All your works shall give thanks to you, O LORD,
and all your faithful shall bless you.*

*¹¹ They shall speak of the glory of your kingdom,
and tell of your power,*

*¹² to make known to all people your mighty deeds,
and the glorious splendor of your kingdom.*

*¹³ Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom,
and your dominion endures throughout all generations.*

*The LORD is faithful in all his words,
and gracious in all his deeds.*

*¹⁴ The LORD upholds all who are falling,
and raises up all who are bowed down.*

*¹⁵ The eyes of all look to you,
and you give them their food in due season.*

*¹⁶ You open your hand,
satisfying the desire of every living thing.*

*¹⁷ The LORD is just in all his ways,
and kind in all his doings.*

*¹⁸ The LORD is near to all who call on him,
to all who call on him in truth.*

*¹⁹ He fulfills the desire of all who fear him;
he also hears their cry, and saves them.*

*²⁰ The LORD watches over all who love him,
but all the wicked he will destroy.*

*²¹ My mouth will speak the praise of the LORD,
and all flesh will bless his holy name forever and ever.*

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit,

As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Conclude with the Prayer after Communion.

4- Recite the following prayer :

You call to us, Lord Jesus,

On your path of light and life;
Make us follow you, Lord Jesus
In faith, in love.

You are the Good News, freeing us from sin;
You open to your brothers and sisters,
The way of holiness!

You gather into one people
The people from every land;
Children of God, in the Church, united by charity.

You invite your disciples to journey to the cross;
You show them hope, where your path leads them.

Conclude with the Prayer after Communion.
