**Reflecting on the Gospel:** *"Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you."*

We like to determine who is rightly following Christ – judging the habits, tastes, fashion choices, or political ideologies of everyone around us. But these calculating practices are foolish in God's eyes. Stop condemning. Stop judging. Be merciful, just as God the Father is merciful. Being merciful does not mean that we might not exhort others to righteous or moral actions, or invite others to better habits or to practice virtues. But mercy is a key that plays in love. Jesus invites us to tune ourselves to him – and so love one another, as he has loved us.

He calls us not to self-preservation but to live with the radical love and generosity that he will model when he washes his disciples' feet and ultimately lays down his very life for us.
